Who should enroll in 5K? Any student who will turn 5 before September 1, 2017

4 Year Old Kindergarten

Who should enroll in 4K? Any student who will turn 4 before September 1, 2017, and meet the additional requirement listed on the back of this page.

Where can you enroll your child?

1. Online at www.anderson2.org (Click on the registration link.)
2. Honea Path Elementary

When can you enroll your child?

1. You can enroll your child online at anytime.
2. You can enroll at HPE on Monday - Friday from 8:15 to 3:15

Why should you enroll now instead of waiting until the end of summer?

1. By enrolling now you will help us determine staff needs for your child.
2. It will be one less thing you have to worry about at the end of summer.

What will you need to enroll your child?

1. Parent/Legal Guardianship Verification

- a. Government Issued Photo ID
- b. Divorce/Separation Documents, if parents have divorced
- c. Court-Ordered Guardianship Papers, if applicable (*A notarized statement from parent or legal guardian is not sufficient.*)

2. Student Information (First time enrolling in Anderson School District 2, or returning Anderson School District 2 student following a break in enrollment.)

- a. State/County issued **certified** birth certificate
- b. Immunization Certificate or 30-Day Waiver (available at school) - Must show "Meets daycare and school requirements"

3. Proof of Residency (at least two of the following are required.) **All students must live in Anderson School District 2 and the Honea Path Elementary attendance zone. Proofs of residence will be checked for all students to ensure that students attending HPE live in our attendance zone.**

- a. Current electric and/or gas bill displaying service address and a billing date within the past 30 days
- b. Closing statement or current mortgage statement for primary residence showing property address (*not mailing address*)

- c. Current signed lease agreement with name and phone number of landlord
 - d. Most recent state or federal income tax return
 - e. Current paid tax receipt on residence owned by parent/legal guardian
 - f. Current statement from DSS or other government agency which proves residency of the parent/legal guardian
 - g. Current paycheck stub with address of residence
4. **Additional Student Information** *(Not required but can be submitted at parent's discretion.)*
- a. Court order or legally binding document restricting parent(s) access to educational records.
 - b. Written consent by parent (legal guardian) that step-parent/other caregiver be granted access to educational records
 - c. Request to restrict release of Student Directory Information *(form available at school)*

(Certain circumstances may necessitate additional enrollment documentation.)

- *Notarized Educational Affidavit*
- *Notarized Residency Affidavit and minimum 2 proofs of address (from above list)*
- *Notarized Custodial Parent Affidavit*

4K Eligibility Requirements

1. Student(s) must qualify for Free/Reduced lunch program **OR** receive Medicaid services. The chart below contains the earning limits to qualify for the Free/Reduced lunch program.
