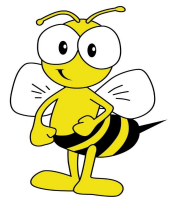

Theme: "Reach the Stars with Reading"

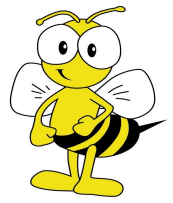
Date/Time: March 1 - 5:30 to 7:00
