Reading Expectations and i-Ready

Fountas & Pinnell

- F&P is a text gradient scale that levels books based on text features.
- Levels range from **Pre- A** (beginning k5) - **Z** (8th grade+)
- Students are expected to progress through certain levels as the year goes on.
- End of year expectations are as follows :

Grade	End of year F&P Level
Kindergarten	D
1st Grade	J
2nd Grade	M
3rd Grade	P
4th Grade	S
5th Grade	V



Text Examples

Level A (Beginning Kindergarten)

This is a kitten.

Level D (End of Kindergarten)

Foxes are mammals. They have thin legs and bushy tails.



Text Examples

Level M (Beginning of 3rd)

Birds that hunt and eat other animals are called “birds of prey.” Birds of prey have strong feet with talons, or claws.

Level V (End of 5th)


This nocturnal creature was attracted to your light. As you watch it crawl its way through the dead leaves and dirt, you see the thick mandibles on its head.



i-Ready - Diagnostic Testing

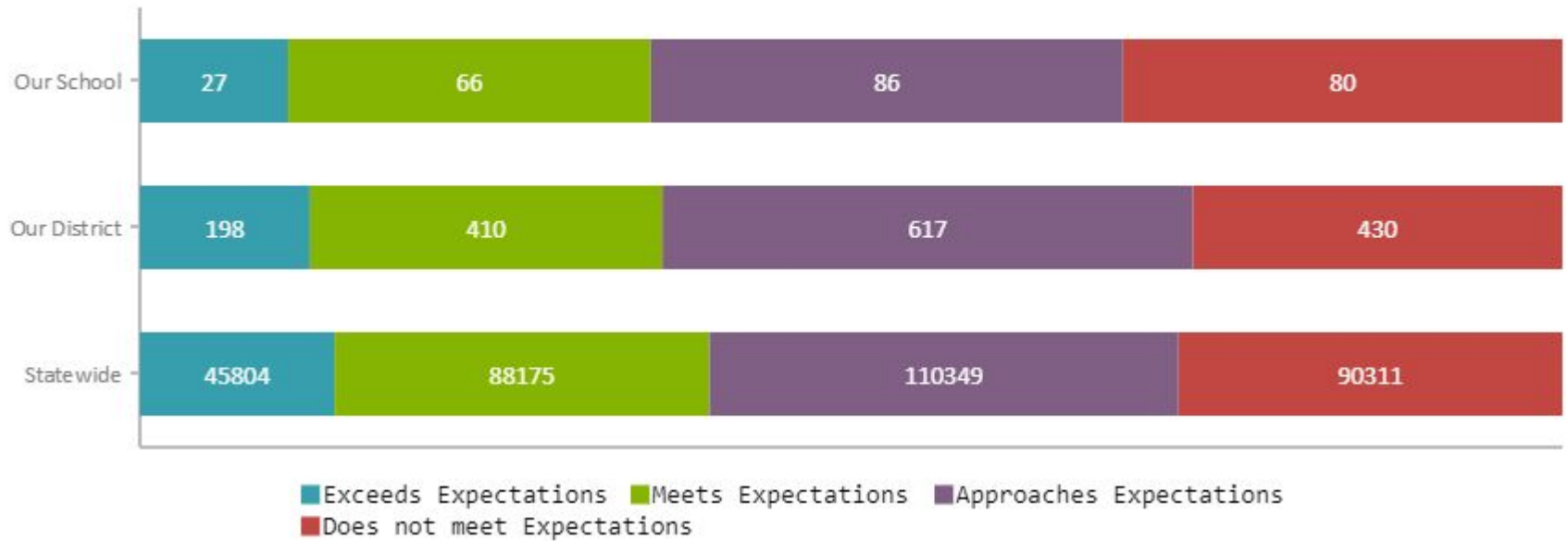
i-Ready is a standard aligned diagnostic test given 3 times a year.

Beginning of the year. Middle of the year. End of the year.

- Tracks student growth
 - Those who score on grade level are considered meeting the expectation of grade level standards.
 - Helps guide teacher instruction throughout the year.
 - Students may complete lessons at home. Student know their passwords.
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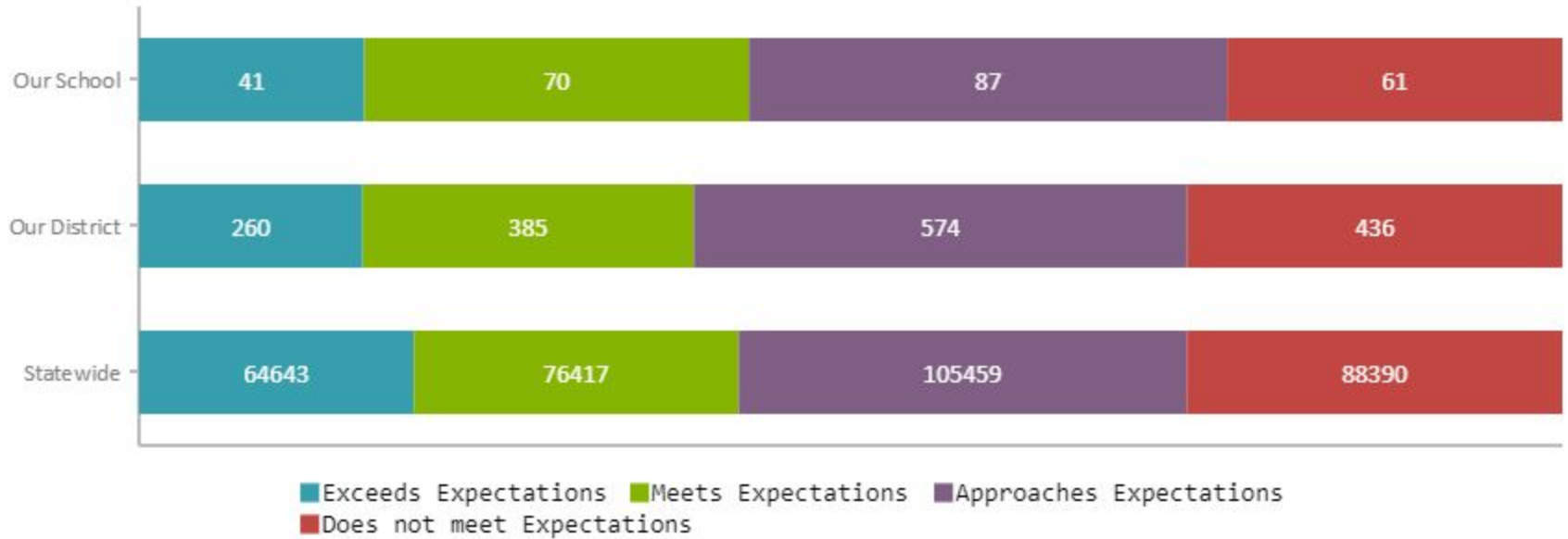

How is this determined?

Grades/ Reading Level / I-ready Data



SC Ready 3rd -5th grades

Students who score a Not Met 1 on SCReady will be required to repeat 3rd grade

Certain good cause exemptions may apply.

End of the Year examples.

Student A-- **550-600+** I ready , **O/P+** F&P, **Approaches /Met / Exemplary** SCReady

Student B-- **511 or below** I ready, **L/M or below** F&P, **Not Met /Not Met 1** SCReady. Student will go to a Summer Reading Camp to show improvement or will be retained.

Student C-- Off Grade Level but has a good cause exemption.



What does this mean for you? The Parents.

- Talk with your Teachers....
 - Ask for your child's F and P score
 - Find out what you can do to help improve their level.
 - Ask for your child's i-Ready reports
 - i-Ready produces a report specifically for your child. The report contains areas for improvement.
 - Find out what you can do at home to help your child.
